Who can be first to catch a hamster?

A reaction game for 2 to 6 players  
from 3½ years.



**Game type:** Reaction game  
**Players:** 2 to 6 players from 3½ years  
**Contents:** 4 hamster cards,  
3 colour dice,  
12 wooden pieces,  
1 instructions

## Preparation

The hamster cards are placed face-up in the middle of the table within reach of all players. The eldest player takes charge of the game and has the 12 game pieces in front of him to give one to the winner of each round.

## Aim of the game

The players try to be the first to find the right hamster. The first one to have their hand on the correct card, receives a game piece. The player with the quickest reactions wins the most pieces and therefore, the game.

## Course of the game

The lightest player begins. He throws all three dice and all players get ready to grab the hamster indicated there.

### Three different colours are shown on the dice

If there are three different colours, the hamster with trousers of the colour **not shown** is correct (this will always be the red trousers as there is no red on the dice).

### One colour appears 2 or 3 times

If a colour appears more than once, the hamster with this colour trousers is correct.

The first person to note the colour lays his hand **on the indicated card** in the middle. All players, including the player throwing the dice can look for the right hamster.

**The player with the fastest reactions** receives a game piece from the player in charge. After each round, the dice are passed on to the next player in a clockwise direction.

## End of the game

The game ends after 12 rounds when all the game pieces have been given out. The winner is the player with the most pieces.

## Variation with minus points

The basic rules are the same but if a player chooses the wrong hamster, he has to return a game piece to the player in charge. If the player has yet to win a piece, nothing happens and the game continues.
